GRANT GUIDELINES

Applicants must be a 501(c)(3) organization in good standing.

Educational and research projects must be consistent with the Foundation's Mission and Four Focus areas:

- Vulvovaginal pain disorders
- Sexual health issues related to perimenopause and menopause
- Intimacy-related issues after cancer treatments
- Libido and sexual desire

Applications for operating costs, partisan, individual churches, indigent care subsidy, travel loans, or for individuals will not be accepted.

Applications will not be considered for any of the following:

- Indirect cost related to the project in excess of 10%
- Amount requested for Predictive Index salaries cannot exceed 30%
- Reimbursement of expenses for activities completed prior to submission and/or approval of the application
- Alcohol, personal expenses unrelated to the project, and any other costs deemed to be unacceptable by the Foundation's Board of Directors
- Submitted by a member of the Foundation's Board of Directors

February 7, 2020	Deadline to submit LOI
March 25, 2020	Deadline to complete Full application
April 2020	Foundation Board meeting to review grant applications
May 1, 2020	Grant applicants to be notified of Board decisions
May 31, 2020	Disbursement of first grant payment for 2020 recipients
November 1, 2020	Grant recipient progress report to Foundation
December 31, 2020	Disbursement of second grant payment for 2020 recipients
