GRANT GUIDELINES

Applicants must be a 501(c)(3) organization in good standing.

Educational and research projects must be consistent with the Foundation's Mission and Six Focus areas:

- Vulvovaginal Pain Disorders
- Impact of Perimenopause and Menopause on Sexual Health
- Intimacy-Related Sexual Dysfunction After Cancer Treatment
- Libido and Sexual Desire
- Physical and Sexual Abuse
- Female Genital Mutilation

Applications for operating costs, partisan groups, individual churches, indigent care subsidies, travel loans, or for individuals will not be accepted.

Applications will not be considered for any of the following:

- Indirect cost related to the project in excess of 10%
- Amount requested for personnel support cannot exceed 20%
- Reimbursement of expenses for activities completed prior to submission and/or approval of the application
- Alcohol, personal expenses unrelated to the project, and any other costs deemed to be unacceptable by the Foundation's Board of Directors
- Submitted by a member of the Foundation's Board of Directors

March 25, 2021	Deadline to complete Full application
April 21, 2021	Foundation Board meeting to review grant applications
May 2021	Grant applicants to be notified of Board decisions
