GRANT GUIDELINES

Applicants must be a 501(c)(3) organization in good standing.

Educational and research projects must be consistent with the Foundation's Mission and six focus areas:

- Vulvovaginal Pain Disorders
- Impact of Perimenopause and Menopause on Sexual Health
- Intimacy-Related Sexual Dysfunction After Cancer Treatment
- Libido and Sexual Desire
- Physical and Sexual Abuse
- Female Genital Mutilation

Organizations prioritizing these six areas related to projects and/or programs will have the most success securing a grant. **In 2022, the Foundation will also give special consideration to projects related to endometriosis and transgender health.**

Applications for operating costs, partisan groups, individual churches, indigent care subsidies, travel loans, or for individuals will not be accepted.

Applications will not be considered for any of the following:

- Indirect cost related to the project in excess of 10%
- Amount requested for personnel support exceeds 25%
- Reimbursement of expenses for activities completed prior to submission and/or approval of the application
- Alcohol, personal expenses unrelated to the project, and any other costs deemed to be unacceptable by the Foundation's Board of Directors
- Submitted by a member of the Patty Brisben Foundation's Board of Directors

April 20, 2022	Foundation Board meeting to review grant applications
